

# Main sight-seeing areas

- Tokyo Skytree 13 minute ride from Mitsukoshimae Station on the Tokyo Metro Hanzōmon Line to Oshiage Station.
- Tokyo Tower A 6 minute ride from Mitsukoshimae Station on the Tokyo Metro Hanzōmon Line Mitsukoshimae Station to Onarimon Station on the Toei Mita Line, transferring at Otemachi Station.
- Asakusa 12 minute ride from Mitsukoshimae Station on the Tokyo Metro Ginza Line.
- Shibuya 20 minute ride on from Mitsukoshimae Station on the Tokyo Ginza Line.
- Ginza 5 minute ride from Mitsukoshimae Station on the Tokyo Ginza Line.

### Access by train

- 11 minute walk using the shortest route from JR Tokyo Station Nihonbashi exit.
- 7 minute walk from JR Kanda Station east exit.
- Links on directly to Shin-Nihombashi Station on the Sobu Line (Express).
- Links on directly to Mitsukoshimae Station on the Tokyo Ginza Line / Tokyo Metro Hanzōmon Line.
- 8 minute walk from the B12 exit of Nihombashi Station on the Tokyo Metro Tōzai Line / Toei Asakusa Line.

### Access by car

- 4 minutes from the Gofukubashi ramp off the Metropolitan Expressway Edobashi JCT.
- 4 minutes from the Edobashi ramp off the Metropolitan Expressway Kanbashi JCT.
   We do not have a car park.

### Access from the airport

#### From Haneda Airport

- 30 minutes by car.
- 40 minutes by limousine bus (arriving at Tokyo Station Yaesu south exit)
- 30 minutes by the Tokyo Monorail or JR Yamanote Line, getting off at Tokyo Station
- 33 minutes on the Keikyu Airport Line by the Airport Express train from Shinagawa Station, transferring at Shinagawa to JR Yamanote Line and getting off at Tokyo Station.

#### From Narita Airport

- 95 minutes by limousine bus (arriving at the Tokyo Station Yaesu south exit)
- 60 minutes by the JR Narita Express, getting off at Tokyo Station
- 90 minutes on the JR Sobu Line, getting off at Shin-Nihombashi Station
